2024-2025 Academic Year Tuition

As it is a matter of justice, contractual obligation, and the financial stability of the school, parents must take their tuition obligations seriously. During FACTS enrollment / re-enrollment, parents are required to select a tuition payment plan with automatic tuition payments. Options for weekly, bi-weekly, semi-monthly, monthly, semi-annual, and annual payments are available. Please note that FACTS will charge a one-time payment plan “enrollment fee” of \$25 (per family) for all tuition plans with 1 or 2 payments and \$55 for all plans with 3 or more payments.

The one-time payment plan “enrollment fee” is separate and distinct from application and re-enrollment fees. It is only the application and re-enrollment fees that qualify for waiver with timely applications and re-enrollments in the Spring each year. It is only in the case of payment plans consisting of a single payment that St. Marys Academy pays the \$25 fee allowing it to be waived for such families.

Parents, who for valid reasons cannot meet their obligation as agreed upon during enrollment, must contact Accounting for modification to the timing of payment or contact the Financial Aid Department regarding an application for financial assistance.

Late fees are applied to payments that are not made in accordance with the tuition payment plan. The school may require parents to withdraw students until they can meet financial obligations. The school reserves the right to withhold report cards, transcripts, and diplomas in these cases.

Each year, the school can provide a limited amount of financial assistance to families in legitimate need, though the amount available depends entirely on benefactor donations earmarked for this purpose. To be considered for financial aid assistance, applicants must:

- Submit a completed financial aid application by April 30th for the subsequent academic year. The application is submitted online through FACTS, which is linked from the school's website, and requires submission of the previous year's tax return and other financial information.
- Maintain a monthly payment schedule as developed with the Financial Aid Department.
- Support and participate actively in all official school fundraisers.

Families receiving financial aid will be asked to contribute to the overall good of the school by performing some assigned volunteer work or services.
